

What is a Refuge Recovery Group?

Refuge Recovery meetings are held by Refuge Recovery groups. Individual RR groups who hold RR meetings are the foundation of our recovery society.

Each RR group holds a group business meeting. The group business meeting is where we first find the day-to-day business of RR being taken care of. We have rent to pay, books to order, and a meeting space to be kept clean. We have a time schedule to follow, announcements to be made, and many other things to be done for the maintenance of the group. The group must stay in contact with other groups in their local area so they can find out about activities, learn of new groups, join with other groups to plan activities, and find out what is happening in RR overall. This is also the first point at which RR funds are handled, and the correct use of this money is essential for the preservation of the group.

RR groups are supported by a democratic service structure and a dedicated non-profit service organization, Refuge Recovery World Services.
